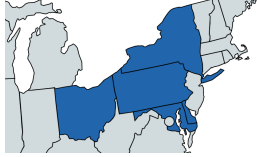


Keeping PennBid Users informed of the latest features and functionality.

PROPOSALS MUST BE MAILED OR OTHERWISE DELIVERED TO THE OFFICE ADDRESS:

The contractor proposes to furnish and deliver all materials, including Form CE-471, CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE, and all other items and materials required by the BIDDING CERTIFICATION, used to do and perform all work in the bid project as more specifically set forth in the General and Special Instructions, in accordance with drawings, as well as the requirements and specifications on file at the office of the project engineer and approved PennDOT Specifications (Publication 802), except (a) sections need not be prepared by PennDOT (see 802.011) and (b) sections of the specifications are not applicable to this project.

Multi-Prime Project Bids

Did you know that you can easily create a multi-prime project in PennBid so that all contracts (such as General Construction, Electrical, Plumbing, HVAC, etc.) are managed within one solicitation?

While the basic framework is similar to a single-prime project, there are some nuances and features to consider with multi-primers.

For the many agencies posting projects using a PA-DOT Form MS-944 or MS-968, we would like to remind you that those forms contain several "Bidder Acknowledgments" and "Bidder Certifications".

Replicating these completely within the "Bid Form - Questions" tab to accurately capture the information that is being sought will result in a completely electronic version of the PA-DOT bid form.
